- A. The Applicant by her counsel has given the usual undertaking as to damages, extending to the goods of all group members in the proceeding which are the subject of the below orders.



THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Until further order or the final determination of this proceeding, pursuant to subsection 177(1) of the *National Consumer Credit Protection Act 2009* (Cth) and sections 23 and 33ZF of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth), the Respondent be restrained from dealing with any of the Pawned Goods as defined in the schedule to these orders.
2. Order 1 does not prevent the Respondent from returning the Pawned Goods to the Group Members or the Applicant at the Respondent's expense without requiring the payment of any charges under the Pawn Contracts.
3. Costs be reserved.
